Test Site Information

The test will be inside in a climate controlled room with rubber flooring. There is no indoor crating space available; dogs must be crated in your car. **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES.** Please use grassy areas around parking lot for toileting of dogs. Please pick up after your dogs.

Entry Requirements

The handler of the dog must be a current member of the NACSW™. The Dog must be registered with the NACSW™ and have a scorebook with his/her own registration number. For information on how to register or become a member go to www.NACSW.net

Entry Fee and Second Dog Policy

\$25.00 per dog. One dog per handler only; no second dogs.

Closing Date

Saturday, October 29, 2011 at 5:00pm
Overnight mail entries must have the signature request waived.

Refund Policy

Cancellations made before October 29 will receive a refund. Cancellations may be made by e-mail (bouv329@gmail.com) or telephone (678-622-8822). The secretary is not responsible for lost e-mails or calls that do not reach her. The secretary will send an e-mail back to the participant confirming the cancellation within 36 business hours. **ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the NACSW™ official or judge.

Reactive Dog Policy

All dogs having reactivity issues to other dogs will be given a red bandana at check in (or bring your own) to wear. For the safety of the dog, s/he **MUST** wear it as long as s/he is on-site. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Directions

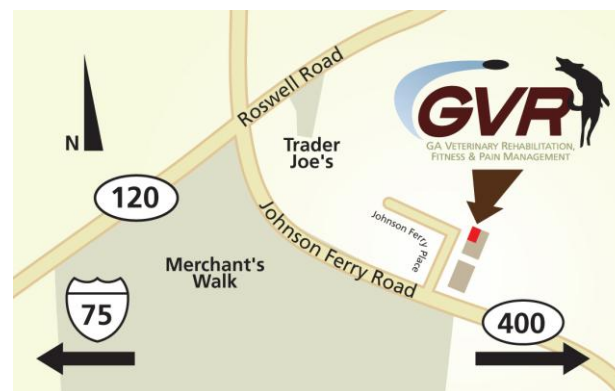
NOTE: If entering address in your GPS or mapping software, use 1230 Johnson Ferry PLACE (not Road).

➡ GVR is located in the **Johnson Ferry Professional Building**, which is off of Johnson Ferry Place. From Johnson Ferry Road, turn onto Johnson Ferry Place (immediately across from the Market Plaza Shopping Center); look for a car wash and Stor-All on corner. Once on Johnson Ferry Place, turn right into the second driveway and immediately turn left; parking is alongside building. For reactive dog parking, turn into driveway, stay straight, pass building, then turn left to park on far side of building (building #2). GVR's entrance is at the far corner of the building, down the hill, suite J-70.

From Highway 400: Exit 5, Abernathy Road, toward Sandy Springs. Follow Abernathy, crossing over Roswell Road. Abernathy Rd becomes Johnson Ferry Rd. (stay slight right). Follow Abernathy/Johnson Ferry Rd. for approximately six miles. Johnson Ferry Place will be on your right at a light, just after Princeton Lakes Dr. Pick up at ➡ above.

From Roswell Road (120)/Marietta: turn onto Johnson Ferry Rd (heading southeast). Travel approx ½ mile; take 2nd left onto Johnson Ferry Place. Pick up at ➡ above.

TEST INFORMATION - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE TEST SITE will be open from 9am – 3pm. Exhibitors are reminded not to arrive at the test site early, nor to visit the test site in advance for training or familiarization.

CHECK-IN: 9 am for first group; 12:30pm for second group (if two groups needed).

HANDLER BRIEFING: 9:30 am for first group; 1 pm for second group (if two groups needed).

Exhibitors must bring their dog's SCOREBOOK with them to the test. Results are recorded in the SCOREBOOK.

NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE SEARCH AREA during the ORT except NACSW™ officials, adults accompanying a minor, or, at the discretion of the certifying official, CNWI-in-training, and immediate family members/friends of the dog/handler team currently being tested.

ENTRIES:

- TELEPHONE, FAX, UNSIGNED ENTRIES, AND ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES cannot be accepted.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
- ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON THE ATTACHED ENTRY FORM.
- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- OWNERS are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.
- EXPRESS MAIL entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged. Be prepared to keep your dog in your car when not being tested or on leash at all times. There is no inside crating at this test.

FEMALES IN SEASON – Contact your test host if this becomes a possibility

DOGS PARTICIPATING in ORT must be at least six months of age and must appear to be healthy on trial day and should be current on all vaccinations required by law.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE/CONFIRMATION will be made when entries are processed for those handlers that provide an email address. If you require a confirmation via USPS, you must provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry.

BASIC DESCRIPTION OF TEST – to successfully pass an ORT a dog must identify the location of the target odor and the handler must correctly call an "alert" within a three-minute time period. The Odor Recognition Test consists of a drill type exercise which requires 12 closed boxes set up in a pattern of one or two rows, spaced a minimum of 48" apart. The ORT is conducted on leash. Complete information can be obtained on the NACSW™ website.
